LITTER BINS I have requested another litter bin to be placed at the beginning of the unmetalled

continuation of Whitehill Farm Road. I have not received any response to date.

POTHOLES I have made a second report regarding potholes on Cumbernauld Road between

Coshneuk Road and Comrie Road to Glasgow City Council but have received no responses from any so far.

ROADSIDE LITTER I received a reply from NLC that litter left on Lenzie Road will be lifted as soon as possible.

FALLEN SIGN at corner of Cardowan Road and Cardowan Drive reported.

FLOODING IN CARDOWAN ROAD AT BANNATYNE'S I reported flooding in Cardowan Road to NLC and Scottish Power due to the presence of an electricity substation in the area. I subsequently received an email from Alice telling me that Councillor Williams had also intervened and a reply had been received

from NLC roads and maintenance manager to arrange cleaning and jetting of the system to solve the problem.

TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT GATESIDE FARM ESTATE. I reported the new traffic signal rotation at the junction of the entrance to the Gateside farm Estate and the main A80 Dual Carriageway as they appear to be set in favour of traffic leaving the estate at present instead of the main thoroughfare.

LENZIE ROAD at present on one way traffic due to Virgin (cable laying apparently).

LENZIE ROAD bushes at sides of road have been cut back.

WHITEHILL FARM ROAD Works being carried out on behalf of Scottish Power at site of the recently fitted offset fence.

UNCOVERED SURFACE DRAIN Following last month's meeting I investigated the report of an uncovered drain in Lenzie Road which represented a very real hazard to traffic using the road. The cover appears to have been replaced.

SELF SEEDING TREES I am pleased to report that Caledonian Estates have cut back the fast growing self-seeding trees from the field in Whitehill Farm.

SHRUBS BEHIND PHARMACY NLC will undertake the work prior to the commencement of the grass cutting season.

GAP IN FENCE HORNSHILL FARM ROAD Meeting with Cllr McLaren – remove fencing at this point.

ROAD BRUSH Barratt and they have confirmed that road brushes are currently running Monday

through to Friday , this is joint between Barratt and Cala. There is also a one way system in place for site deliveries. These deliveries are not permitted into the build zone and must follow the delivery route which is in place to help minimise mud being taken back out on to public roads. There is also no construction traffic permitted within occupied areas of the site again to control mud being taken from the site

FLOODING CARDOWAN ROAD Reported by resident - There is a recurring flooding problem on Cardowan Road, from the entrance to St Joseph's Parish Centre to the corner of Ardtoe Crescent. Every time it rains with any volume we see a large puddle develop, one which covers eastern side of the road, causing most drivers to use the opposite side of the road, while the drivers who do

drive through the puddle risk flooding their cars and soaking pedestrians passing by, many of whom are school children, asit is near the entrance to the school.
